

The Registration process is only as good as the people who register their plants, and the quality of the information that they provide. I want to thank all who have taken the time to make this an informative and educational effort. There are 179 new registrations for 2011. There are now a total of 4988 registered hostas.

The effort continues to be invigorated by the in depth research and knowledge of W. George Schmid and Warren Pollock, and Mark Zilis.

As was announced two years ago, the comprehensive index has become excessively long, due to the large number of recent registrations. Therefore, the index will now be published exclusively on-line. This decision may be reevaluated in the future if we receive a substantial number of requests for a hardcopy publication of the Index.

Data Base “Errors” (and their correction): I encourage anyone finding what they believe to be errors write me and let me know so that I can research the matter and make appropriate changes to the record.

Where it is a clear typographical error made by the registrar in recording the data, changes can be made with little effort. However, where the data was contained on the original registration form the registrar must first attempt to contact the original registrant to approve the changes. Thus, even though a change should be made as correct information is now known there may be reasons other than the registrar forgetting to make the correction as to why the change was not made, and in fact the registrar may be prohibited from making the changes. Nonetheless, I encourage you to bring any items that do not make sense to you to my attention.

Ploidy: The newest issue we are facing in the Registration area is that of ploidy. A special thanks goes to Ben J. M. Zonneveld who has taken the time to edit my ramblings herein on the subject so that it is coherent to the average reader. The issue has been raised that a few hostas have been registered recently indicating that they may be tetraploid or polyploid. What does this mean?

Polyploid: The occurrence of related forms possessing chromosome numbers which are multiples of a basic number (x), the haploid number. Forms having $3x$ chromosomes are triploids; $4x$, tetraploids; $6x$, hexaploids, and so on. Autopolyploids are forms derived by the multiplication of chromosomes from a single species. These are distinguished from allopolyploids, which are forms derived from a hybrid between two different species. The polyploidy condition can be induced artificially with chemicals and the production of polyploid individuals has become a valuable tool for plant breeding.

Thus, it has been argued that thick leaf substance is one such indicator of polyploidy – especially when the sport is more heavily substantiated than its parent or when the seedling is more heavily substantiated than either of the parents. At the same time, it has been pointed out that thick leaf substance itself does not necessarily indicate polyploidy.

Clearly thickness alone is not a direct indicator of polyploidy, otherwise, all *H. ‘Sieboldiana’* types would be tetraploid and they are not. At the same time, when comparing Hosta "A" to its sport, Hosta "B" and discovering that "B" has **noticeably changed** its leaf thickness and is a much different plant from "A", one possible, even likely, explanation is a change in ploidy level. There are many such examples among hostas. Out of ‘Francee’ came thicker-leaved ‘Patriot’, which can be both fully tetraploid and partial tetraploid (polyploid chimera).

At the same time we are not certain of the ploidy of others, thus, should the registrar allow under the category “**What diagnostic characteristics make this cultivar unique from other hostas?**” such phrasing as: “exhibits thick substance, etc., indicating polyploidy, but designation as tetraploid or ploidy chimera has not been confirmed.”

I have been advised that we should not indicate ploidy unless it has been scientifically determined. That notwithstanding, for the present I am not going to “ban” the use of the term, but will be evaluating its use on a case by case basis, until such time as the evidence provides me with a clear path.

New Form Attached: The good news is that about 90 percent of you read this Introduction and consequently used the new form and no one failed to notice the **NEW DEADLINE of November 1 for submitting registrations.**

Plant Patents, Plant Breeder’s Rights and Establishment: Article 31.2 of the *Code* (8th Edition; 2009) under Article 31. Rejection of Names: "... the name of a cultivar accepted and published by a statutory plant registration authority, even if using alternative terminology must not be rejected under the provisions of this *Code*."

In keeping with this provision, included on page 26-7 is a table of hostas that have been processed under one of these pieces of legislation. The table also indicates which have already been registered. Those which have not been registered have been established and thus, those names although, not registered, are not available for use by any other person. Of note, of the 105 cultivars granted these other protections (of which 4 have since expired), 74 are already registered. Thus, it is reassuring that most still feel the registration process is as valuable, if not more so, as the legal protections afforded by certain jurisdictions.

Plant Patent Applied For (“PPAF”): The U.S. Patent Office now only publishes patent applications if the applicants request that the filings be published. Otherwise applications are not available until the patents are granted, when patent numbers with dates are issued. On occasion people registering hostas intended to file for plant patents, but then did not. This has resulted in the Hosta Registry incorrectly representing some hostas as PPAF. Thus starting in 2010, the DATES of the actual U.S. patent application filings must be supplied to the registrar by the hosta registrants for their plants to be listed as PPAF. Note that PPAF does not necessarily mean a U.S. plant patent is forthcoming. The Patent Office may determine the application not patentable or the application may be abandoned.

Measurements: An interesting issue has arisen regarding leaf size measurements and rounding when comparing data accessed through the online database and what was published in the Registration Issue. The hosta in question was 'Frosted Mouse Ears' (My! How all these mouse ears are mischievous!). Well, in programming the online database we thought we were doing all a favor rounding the leaf sizes to the nearest inch size and the centimeters to the nearest centimeter.

When searched on-line the description states: Leaf: 3 in. (6 cm) long; 2 in. (6 cm) wide, thus a slightly oblong leaf becomes a round leaf in transitioning from imperial to metric measurement. How could this be and if it were 3 by 2 it would be more like 7.5 cm by 5 cm. again rounding as (1 inch = 2.54 cm). So what was happening to make this absurdity. Well the measurement as registered was 2.5 in. long, and 2.25 in. wide. Thus, under standard conventions 2.5 in. rounds UP to 3 in. and 2.25 rounds DOWN to 2, as in the 3 by 2 shown by the computer. The program then looks at the cm and sees that for 2.5 inches the metric is 6.4 cm, and for 2.25 it is 5.7 cm. The result when we ask the computer to round those two metric numbers to full cm, the 5.7 rounds UP to 6, and the 6.4 rounds DOWN to 6. Wow! So for small leaves the rounding creates this anomaly, which we are now working on trying to resolve without breaching the other statistical conventions about too many significant digits. Ain't science fun?

Further, after much discussion among the nomenclature committee we will be rounding all measurements to the nearest, single decimal point. Due to the variability among leaves on a plant and among plants of the same cultivar, reporting a measurement to the second, third or even fourth decimal point implies a measurement precision that is just not accurate or true. It may take some time but I intend to adjust all the past measurements in the database to this one decimal place rule. And NO, this does not mean full inch measurements will have a ".0" added!

Special Note: In a recent article W. George Schmid has proposed that the taxon *H. sieboldiana* be reduced to cultivar rank in accordance with the *International Code of Nomenclature for Cultivated Plants* (ICNCP). Refer to the American Hosta Society 2011 *Online Hosta Journal*, Vol. 42; under the section "Genus *Hosta*" by W.G. Schmid: *H. sieboldiana* or *H. 'Sieboldiana'*: Species or Cultivar? or refer to the *AHS 'Tan Book'* (*List of Species, Botanical Varieties, and Forms* (under the *International Code of Botanical Nomenclature* (VIENNA CODE) and *Species reduced to Cultivar Rank* (under the ICNCP) posted on the AHS web site as http://www.americanhostasociety.org/PDF/tan_book_hosta_species_botanical_varieties_forms.pdf. The applicable plant description and synonyms are published in W.G. Schmid (1991) *The Genus Hosta - Giboshi Zoku*; Chapter 3, Part 2; Pages 93-94; 317-318. Timber Press; Portland, Oregon, USA.

Although this has been proposed there is still some discussion over the impact of such a change and the registrar has determined that for purposes of this publication, albeit the likely result, and acknowledges the proposed change, wishes to have benefit of further discussion before fully memorializing such change.

Controversy Regarding Certain Registered Hostas: It has come to the attention of the Registrar that there is a serious controversy over the origin of many plants introduced and registered in such a way that they may be interpreted to have been originated by Paul Aden. It has been reported that many of these plants were originated by others, many of the top hybridizers of the day, including Kevin Vaughn, Chet Tompkins, Florence Shaw, and possibly several others, as well as a number of Japanese cultivars and in many cases were obtained by Paul Aden ostensibly for trial purposes or, in yet other cases, through allegedly nefarious means. To the knowledge of the Registrar, no litigation has issued against Paul or his estate to establish true ownership of numerous cultivars, and the passage of time may have rendered these cases impossible as beyond statutes of limitation, or due to the absence of a solid chain of evidence. Nevertheless, the number of cases of disputed origination is significant. Therefore an "*" will be placed by the Registrar, in the space designated for "originator" on all Aden registrations. The "*" is intended to indicate that the origin of this plant is undocumented and is not considered originated by Aden.

The purpose of the registration process and the job of the registrar is to record known cultivars and to get the information as accurate as possible for those cultivars. In the early 1990s the American Hosta Society moved to a system where the originator, the nominant, the introducer, and the registrant are separately recorded. Thus, from time to time, it may be appropriate, where sufficient documentation can be obtained, to amend information for cultivars registered before the use of the ONIR system, and even for those registered thereafter by the AHS as a means to get cultivars in the trade into an archival system.
