S. Chamberlain (ONIR)

Plant: 40in (101.6cm) diameter; 20in (50.8cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 8in (20.3cm) long; 7in (17.8cm) wide; 9 vein pairs; greenish yellow flat margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; nearly round with flat base; lightly corrugated and lightly flat

Scape: 32 to 36in (81.3 to 91.4cm) high; green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 1.75in (4.4cm) long; pale lavender, light lavender with medium purple striping; tubular; Manlius, NY; 7/10 - 7/25 - 8/5

Seed: sets seeds, viability is unknown, purplish green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 5 years old; Manlius, NY

Notable Characteristics: Spade-shaped leaf; looks like a large chartreuse H. 'Vanilla Cream'
