Plant: 50in (127.0cm) diameter; 21in (53.3cm) high; mound-like; fast growth rate

Leaf: 11.5in (29.2cm) long; 9.5in (24.1cm) wide; 10 vein pairs; yellow flat margins; slightly shiny on top; very shiny underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; moderately flat

Scape: 24 to 31in (61.0 to 78.7cm) high; light purple

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 1.88in (4.8cm) long; near white, pale lavender striped; tubular; Manlius, NY; 7/11 - 7/30 - 8/11

Seed: sets seeds viability is unknown, greenish-yellow pods

Clump History: the original seedling; 4 years old; Manlius, NY

Notable Characteristics: large, mound like yellow hosta, emerges yellow and remains mostly yellow

Pod Parent: H. 'Granary Gold'

Pollen Parent: unknown

Sport Parent: N/A

Seasonal Color Change: yellow to slightly greenish-yellow, slightly viridescent
