Plant: 35in (88.9cm) diameter; 12in (30.5cm) high; upright; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 9in (22.9cm) long; 7in (17.8cm) wide; 14 vein pairs; greenish yellow slightly rippled margins; dull on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly corrugated, moderately flat

Scape: 34 to 36in (86.4 to 91.4cm) high; light green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1.5in (3.8cm) long; near white, pale lavender striped; tubular; Manlius, NY; 6/25 - 7/25 - 7/30

Seed: does not set seed

Clump History: original seedling; 9 years old; Manlius, NY

Notable Characteristics: short, upright gold
