Plant: 18in (45.7cm) diameter; 8in (20.3cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 4.5in (11.4cm) long; 2in (5.1cm) wide; 4 vein pairs; medium blue-green with .25in (0.6cm) wide, yellow to white, slightly rippled margins; dull on top; slightly shiny underneath; ovate with rounded base; lightly cupped

Scape: 23 to 26in (58.4 to 66.0cm) high; medium green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2.38in (6.0cm) long; medium lavender, pale purple striped; tubular; Manlius, NY; 7/16 - 8/26 - 9/10

Seed: sets seeds viability is unknown, dark green pods

Clump History: the original seedling; 5 years old; Manlius, NY

Notable Characteristics: small mound like hosta with clean yellow edge, extended bloom season

Pod Parent: unregistered streaked seedling

Pollen Parent: unknown

Sport Parent: N/A

Seasonal Color Change: margin whitens through season
