Plant: 34in (86.4cm) diameter; 14in (35.6cm) high; upright

Leaf: 9in (22.9cm) long; 5.75in (14.6cm) wide; 12 vein pairs; slightly blue-green with .75 to 1in (1.9 to 2.5cm) wide, light green, slightly rippled margins; glaucous bloom on top; slightly shiny underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly corrugated, moderately flat

Scape: 31 to 33in (78.7 to 83.8cm) high; slightly blue-green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 1.25in (3.2cm) long; near white, faint lavender striped; tubular; Manlius, NY; 6/20 - 7/18 - 7/26

Seed: light green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 5 years old; Manlius, NY

Notable Characteristics: upright, medium sized with subtle variegation
