Plant: 40in (101.6cm) diameter; 14in (35.6cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 7in (17.8cm) long; 5in (12.7cm) wide; 8 to 9 vein pairs; light green slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; slightly shiny underneath; ovate with rounded base; lightly corrugated, moderately flat

Scape: 17 to 22in (43.2 to 55.9cm) high; light green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; pale lavender, medium lavender striped; tubular; Manlius, NY; 7/1 - 7/28 - 8/4

Seed: sets seeds, viability is unknown, light green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 9 years old; Manlius, NY

Notable Characteristics: strongly viridescent, mound-like, medium sized
