Plant: 37in (94.0cm) diameter; 19in (48.3cm) high; mound-like; fast growth rate

Leaf: 8in (20.3cm) long; 5.5in (14.0cm) wide; 10 vein pairs; medium green heavy rippled margins; dull on top; glaucous bloom underneath; ovate with cordate base; lightly corrugated, moderately flat

Scape: 24 to 32in (61.0 to 81.3cm) high; medium green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 1.75in (4.4cm) long; near white, pale lavender striping; tubular; Manlius, NY; 6/3 - 7/5 - 7/20

Seed: sets viable seeds, light to medium green pods

Clump History: the original seedling; 5 years old; Manlius, NY

Notable Characteristics: mound shaped green with a very pronounced rippling of the leaf edges
