Plant: 30in (76.2cm) diameter; 23in (58.4cm) high; upright; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 11.75in (29.8cm) long; 7.5in (19.1cm) wide; 9 to 10 prominent underne vein pairs; medium green streaked with dark green, light green, greenish yellow and yellow heavily rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly twisted and deeply corrugated

Scape: 29 to 32in (73.7 to 81.3cm) high; green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1.88in (4.8cm) long; pale lavender, ; tubular; Ann Arbor, MI; 6/28 - 7/14 - 7/30

Seed: sets seeds, viability is unknown, green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 5 years old; Ann Arbor, MI

Notable Characteristics: large, heavily rippled, recumbent, multi-colored, white-backed, leathery leaves
