Leaf: 4in (10.2cm) long; 3in (7.6cm) wide; 7 to 8 vein pairs; dark green with .5 to 1in (1.3 to 2.5cm) wide, creamy white, slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; slightly shiny underneath; broadly ovate with rounded base; lightly cupped; lightly folded; lightly wavy; lightly flat

Scape: 10 to 15in (25.4 to 38.1cm) high; green

Scape Bracts: N/A

Flower: 1.5 to 2in (3.8cm) long; medium lavender, striped; yellow anthers; tubular; Zionsville, IN; July 1 to July 31

Seed: sets seeds viability is unknown, green pods

Clump History: original sport; 8 years old; Zionsville, IN

Notable Characteristics: medium to small sized hosta with good contrast between the pointed dark green leaves and the creamy white margins that radiate into the central colors of the blade
