Plant: 96in (243.8cm) diameter; 48in (121.9cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 18in (45.7cm) long; 13in (33.0cm) wide; 16 vein pairs; intensely blue green slightly rippled margins; very shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; deeply corrugated

Scape: 48 to 60in (121.9 to 152.4cm) high; green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: pale lavender, ; tubular; Nashville, TN; 6/15 - 6/30 - 7/15

Seed: sets viable seeds

Clump History: division; 5 years old; Nashville, TN

Notable Characteristics: very good substance, intense blue in early spring

Pod Parent: Parentage Unknown grown from seed from Walden West
