H. 'Fall Dazzler'

Unknown (Japan) (O) M. Zilis (NIR)

Plant: 17in (43.2cm) diameter; 8in (20.3cm) high; mound-like; fast growth rate

Leaf: 5in (12.7cm) long; 2.5in (6.4cm) wide; 7 vein pairs; medium green with .1in (0.3cm) wide, white, flat margins; dull on top; thin glaucous bloom underneath; lanceolate with rounded base; lightly wavy

Scape: 9 to 12in (22.9 to 30.5cm) high; green

Scape Bracts: N/A

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; deep purple, ; tubular; Rochelle, IL; 9/29 - 10/9 - 10/18

Seed: sets sparse but viable seeds, green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 3 years old; Rochelle, IL

Notable Characteristics: wild collected form of *H. longipes*; low, dense mound of foliage is attractive all season long, but its flowers in September and October make it one of the best miniature hostas for fall effect.
