Plant: 39in (99.1cm) diameter; 24in (61.0cm) high; upright; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 9.75in (24.8cm) long; 7.25in (18.4cm) wide; 14 prominent underneath vein pairs; dark blue green with unstable streaks of medium green, greenish yellow, pale yellow, yellow and gold slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; deeply corrugated

Scape: 25 to 29in (63.5 to 73.7cm) high; glaucous green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1.75in (4.4cm) long; pale lavender, purple stripe and translucent margins; tubular; Ann Arbor, MI; 7/4 - 7/20 - 8/1

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 6 years old; Ann Arbor, MI

Notable Characteristics: is adorned with a beautiful blue and yellow gown and a white petticoat underneath; streaked throughout
