Leaf: 8.75in (22.2cm) long; 5.5in (14.0cm) wide; 10 vein pairs; medium blue green with .5 to 1in (1.3 to 2.5cm) wide, yellow, flat margins; glaucous bloom on top; glaucous bloom underneath; ovate with rounded base; lightly cupped

Scape: 28 to 32in (71.1 to 81.3cm) high

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2.25in (5.7cm) long; pure white, translucent edge; lightly striped; tubular; North Vancouver, B.C., Canada; 7/15 - 7/24 - 7/30

Seed: sets weakly viable seeds, grayish green pods

Clump History: 3rd generation of the original sport; 5 years old; North Vancouver, B.C., Canada

Notable Characteristics: very attractive, stable, vigorous grower
