## H. 'Fruit Loop'

D. & M. Beilstein (ONIR)

**Plant:** 12in (30.5cm) diameter; 7in (17.8cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

**Leaf:** 3in (7.6cm) long; 3in (7.6cm) wide; 5 to 6 vein pairs; dark green with .25 to .5in (0.6 to 1.3cm) wide, creamy white, flat margins; very shiny on top; very shiny underneath; nearly round with Cordate base; moderately cupped, moderately corrugated

**Scape:** 19 to 0in (48.3 to 0.0cm) high; green

**Scape Bracts:** inflorescence leaves

**Flower:** .75in (1.9cm) long; medium lavender, ; tubular; Mansfield, OH; 8/15 - - 9/2

**Seed:** sets viable seed, dark green pods

**Clump History:** original seedling; 4 years old; Mansfield, OH

**Notable Characteristics:** small hosta is only 7 inches tall and each leaf is fully corrugated and cupped with a cream margin of 1/4 to 1/2 inch on a 3 inch round cupped leaf

**Pod Parent:** (H. 'Minuta' F1 sdlg B x H. 'Shining Tot')

**Pollen Parent:** (H. 'Lakeside Looking Glass' open pollinated sdlg)
