F. Nyikos (ONIR)

Plant: 20in (50.8cm) diameter; 8in (20.3cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 4in (10.2cm) long; 2.75in (7.0cm) wide; 5 to 7 vein pairs; light green irregular creamy white edges and streaking, very slightly rippled margins; dull on top; very shiny underneath; broadly ovate with rounded base; lightly folded, moderately flat

Scape: 14 to 18in (35.6 to 45.7cm) high; streaked green and creamy white

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; deep purple, medium purple on cream with deep purple veins; tubular; Unionville, IN; 7/1 - 7/15 - 7/22

Seed: sets viable seeds

Clump History: the original seedling; 7 years old; Unionville, IN

Notable Characteristics: subtle irregular variegation on small dense clump
