Plant: 24in (61.0cm) diameter; 10in (25.4cm) high; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 6in (15.2cm) long; 4in (10.2cm) wide; 7 to 9 vein pairs; creamy white with .5 to .75in (1.3 to 1.9cm) wide, medium green, slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; slightly shiny underneath; broadly ovate with rounded base; moderately twisted, wavy and flat and lightly corrugated, cupped and folded

Scape: 14 to 20in (35.6 to 50.8cm) high

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; pale lavender, with white edges; tubular; Indianapolis, IN; 7/4 - 7/15 - 7/30

Seed: sets seeds, viability is unknown, white pods

Clump History: original sport; 6 years old; Indianapolis, IN

Notable Characteristics: white center sport which does not melt out in Goodwin garden
