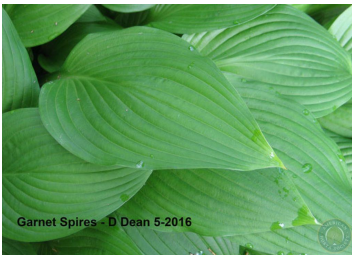

Plant: 38in (96.5cm) diameter; 22in (55.9cm) high; upright; fast growth rate

Leaf: 10in (25.4cm) long; 6in (15.2cm) wide; 8 vein pairs; light green slightly rippled margins; dull on top; dull underneath; broadly ovate with tapered base; lightly wavy, moderately flat

Scape: 21 to 24in (53.3 to 61.0cm) high; saturated garnet then magenta at flowers

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; pale lavender, white to translucent edge; tubular; Ramsey, MN; 8/13 - 8/22 - 9/4

Seed: sets viable seeds, dark green pods

Clump History: 6 years old; Ramsey, MN

Notable Characteristics: erect-flared mound, dense garnet red full scape with strong bright magenta at base of flower bracts, leaf held in line with petiole
