Plant: 29in (73.7cm) diameter; 14in (35.6cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 8in (20.3cm) long; 5in (12.7cm) wide; 8 vein pairs; medium green with .25 to .5in (0.6 to 1.3cm) wide, greenish yellow, slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; ovate with Tapered base; lightly wavy

Scape: 19 to 21in (48.3 to 53.3cm) high; green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; pale lavender, pale lavender outside with dark lavender stripe inside; tubular; Grafton, WI; 8/15 - 9/15 - 10/1

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods

Clump History: the original seedling; 5 years old; Grafton, WI

Notable Characteristics: yellow pigment of the leaf overruns the green pigment and infuses into the green creating a butterscotch color
