Plant: 92in (233.7cm) diameter; 26in (66.0cm) high; mound-like; slow growth rate

Leaf: 13in (33.0cm) long; 10.5in (26.7cm) wide; 16 to 18 vein pairs; medium blue-green flat margins; glaucous bloom on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; moderately wavy, moderately twisted, intensely corrugated

Scape: 32 to 0in (81.3 to 0.0cm) high

Scape Bracts:

Flower: near white, ; tubular; Rochelle, IL; 6/20 - 7/3 - 7/10

Seed: sets viable seed

Clump History: a division of the original; 10 years old; Rochelle, IL

Notable Characteristics: large mound of heavily corrugated, blue-green foliage, introduced in the 1970s in the 'Garden of Aden' catalog

Pod Parent: H. 'Elegans' open pollinated
