Plant: 30in (76.2cm) diameter; 12in (30.5cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 7in (17.8cm) long; 6in (15.2cm) wide; 9 to 10 vein pairs; intensely blue-green heavily rippled, finely and lightly serrated margins; glaucous bloom on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly cupped, lightly folded, deeply wavy, deeply corrugated

Scape: 18 to 21in (45.7 to 53.3cm) high; faintly speckled burgundy on green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves blushed burgundy

Flower: 1.63in (4.1cm) long; near white, faint lavender center on inside; somewhat tubular, somewhat bell; Ramsey, MN; 7/18 - 7/28 - 8/9

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods

Clump History: the original seedling; 7 years old; Ramsey, MN

Notable Characteristics: intense silver-blue, sharp leaf tip twists and curves downward, named for Mary Schwartzbauer's mother
