Leaf: 4in (10.2cm) long; 1.5in (3.8cm) wide; 4 to 5 vein pairs; medium green with .25 to .5in (0.6 to 1.3cm) wide, white, heavily rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; very shiny underneath; lance with Tapered base; lightly cupped, moderately twisted, lightly folded, moderately wavy, lightly corrugated

Scape: 12 to 18in (30.5 to 45.7cm) high; green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; pale to deep purple, white edged petals; tubular; Zionsville, IN; 8/5 - 8/15 - 8/25

Seed: sets viable seed, green pods
