Plant: 41in (104.1cm) diameter; 22in (55.9cm) high; upright; medium-fast growth rate

Leaf: 9in (22.9cm) long; 6.5in (16.5cm) wide; 12 vein pairs; intensely blue green slightly rippled margins; very shiny, glaucous bloom on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; moderately corrugated and lightly cupped

Scape: 28 to 35in (71.1 to 88.9cm) high
