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Plant: 36in (91.4cm) diameter; 28in (71.1cm) high; mound-like; fast growth rate

Leaf: 15in (38.1cm) long; 12in (30.5cm) wide; 10 to 12 vein pairs; medium green with .5in (1.3cm) wide, creamy white to white, slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; dull underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly cupped, lightly folded, lightly wavy

Scape: 28 to 0in (71.1 to 0.0cm) high; green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2.5in (6.4cm) long; pale lavender, ; bell; Preston, MN; 7/10 - 7/15 - 7/20

Seed: sets viable seed, green pods

Clump History: original sport; 3 years old; Preston, MN

Notable Characteristics: very large leaves, differs from parent in much darker green center, slightly shorter habit
