Leaf: 6in (15.2cm) long; 4in (10.2cm) wide; 9 to 10 vein pairs; golden yellow with 1in (2.5cm) wide, creamy white, slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; very shiny underneath; broadly ovate with rounded base; lightly cupped, moderately twisted, moderately folded, moderately wavy, lightly corrugated, flat

Scape: 15 to 18in (38.1 to 45.7cm) high; light green

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; medium lavender, minor striping; tubular; Indianapolis, IN; 7/10 - 7/25 - 8/10

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods
