Plant: 40in (101.6cm) diameter; 23in (58.4cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 10.5in (26.7cm) long; 8.5in (21.6cm) wide; 14 to 15 vein pairs; blue-green streaked green shades, yellow and creamy white heavy rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with Cordate base; lightly cupped, moderately wavy, moderately corrugated

Scape: 28 to 39in (71.1 to 99.1cm) high; glaucous green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2.1in (5.3cm) long; near white, pale lavender striped, translucent edges; open funnel; Ann Arbor, MI; 7/2 - 7/1 - 7/29

Seed: sets viable seeds, green or streaked pods

Clump History: original sport; 4 years old; Ann Arbor, MI

Notable Characteristics: large mound of blue-green rippled foliage, multicolor streaking, thick substance, white backs
