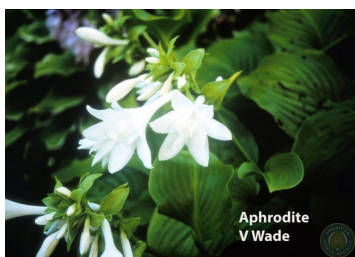

**Plant:** 60in (152.4cm) diameter; 24in (61.0cm) high; mound-like; fast growth rate

**Leaf:** 11in (27.9cm) long; 7.4in (18.8cm) wide; 9 to 11 vein pairs; green margins; shiny on top; shiny underneath; ovate with rounded base; smooth, deeply veined

**Scape:** 18 to 34in (45.7 to 86.4cm) high; green

**Scape Bracts:** N/A

**Flower:** 5in (12.7cm) long; flared trumpet, double perianth; China; Aug 1 to Aug 30

**Seed:** does not set seed

**Clump History:** the original collected in China; China

**Notable Characteristics:** The conversion of the perianth is somewhat unstable, but in most cases the flower has 12 tepals, while the anthers can vary from 3-petaloid to 6-petaloid.
