Plant: 28in (71.1cm) diameter; 13in (33.0cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 8in (20.3cm) long; 6in (15.2cm) wide; 8 to 11 vein pairs; greenish yellow flat margins; dull on top; slightly shiny underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly wavy

Scape: 20 to 25in (50.8 to 63.5cm) high; greenish yellow

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1.75in (4.4cm) long; medium lavender, white edges; tubular; Asbury, IA; 7/2 - 7/9 - 7/16

Seed: sets viable seeds, dark green pods

Clump History: the original seedling; 5 years old; Asbury, IA

Notable Characteristics: heavy, almost rubbery substance, good sun tolerance, holds color well.

Pod Parent: H. 'Rainforest Sunrise'

Pollen Parent: open pollinated

Sport Parent: N/A

Seasonal Color Change: yellow intensifies as season progresses
