Plant: 30in (76.2cm) diameter; 12in (30.5cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 6in (15.2cm) long; 3in (7.6cm) wide; 7 to 8 vein pairs; medium blue-green heavily rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; lanceolate with tapered base; deeply cupped, deeply twisted; deeply folded; intensely wavy

Scape: 18 to 24in (45.7 to 61.0cm) high; blue-green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: pale lavender, ; tubular; Zionsville, IN; 7/1 - 7/15 - 7/31

Seed: sets seeds viability is unknown, blue-green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 10 years old; Zionsville, IN

Notable Characteristics: intense rippling of outer blade; long blade; undulating mass of leaves gives clump interest.
