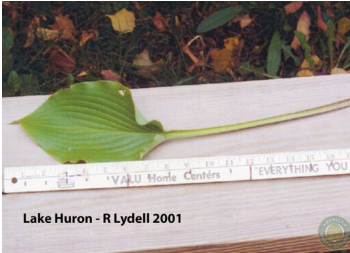

Plant: 40in (101.6cm) diameter; 22in (55.9cm) high; mound-like; fast growth rate

Leaf: 9in (22.9cm) long; 5in (12.7cm) wide; 9 to 10 vein pairs; medium green flat margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; ovate with tapered base; moderately wavy

Scape: 26 to 30in (66.0 to 76.2cm) high; red/brown

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 1.5in (3.8cm) long; pale purple, throat purple with white stripes; tubular; Dunkirk, NY; 10/5 - 10/15 - 10/30

Seed: sets viable seeds, avocado to brown pods

Clump History: Original seedling; 6 years old; Dunkirk, NY

Notable Characteristics: very heavy bloom in late season; red lower on petiole; foliage looks good until frost

Pod Parent: H. pycnophylla (#2) seed from Japan

Pollen Parent: unknown
