Plant: 40in (101.6cm) diameter; 23in (58.4cm) high; upright; fast growth rate

Leaf: 12.5in (31.8cm) long; 10.5in (26.7cm) wide; 16 to 17 vein pairs; medium green with .5 to 1.75in (1.3 to 4.4cm) wide, yellow, slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; nearly round with cordate base; moderately wavy, moderately corrugated

Scape: 26 to 29in (66.0 to 73.7cm) high; glaucous green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2.1in (5.3cm) long; pale lavender, pink striped, translucent edges; tubular; Ann Arbor, MI; 7/2 - 7/17 - 7/29

Seed: green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 6 years old; Ann Arbor, MI

Notable Characteristics: lustrous display of large green leaves with wide bright yellow margins, rippled edges, white backs
