Plant: 42in (106.7cm) diameter; 13in (33.0cm) high; upright; fast growth rate

Leaf: 10.5in (26.7cm) long; 4.5in (11.4cm) wide; 7 to 8 vein pairs; medium green with .25 to .5in (0.6 to 1.3cm) wide, near white, heavy ripples margins; dull on top; glaucous bloom underneath; ovate with cordate base; lightly twisted, deeply wavy edge, moderately corrugated

Scape: 23 to 24in (58.4 to 61.0cm) high; saturated burgundy

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; medium lavender, translucent edge; tubular; Ramsey, MN; 8/7 - 8/16 - 8/25

Seed: sets seed, viability unknown, medium green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 6 years old; Ramsey, MN

Notable Characteristics: very regular spaced piecrusting, saturated burgundy scapes with contrasting creamy green bracts
