Plant: 40in (101.6cm) diameter; 19in (48.3cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 9in (22.9cm) long; 7in (17.8cm) wide; 9 to 10 vein pairs; greenish yellow with .25in (0.6cm) wide, pale yellow, slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; very shiny underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; moderately wavy

Scape: 18 to 24in (45.7 to 61.0cm) high; light green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 2.125in (5.4cm) long; pale lavender, ; tubular; Asbury, IA; 7/12 - 7/24 - 8/2

Seed: sets viable seeds, green with red speckles pods

Clump History: the original seedling; 6 years old; Asbury, IA

Notable Characteristics: very attractive color combination, good growth rate
