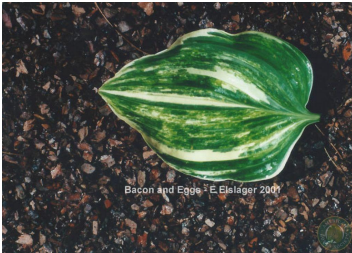

Plant: 22in (55.9cm) diameter; 13in (33.0cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 6in (15.2cm) long; 4.75in (12.1cm) wide; 8 vein pairs; blue green streaked with dark green, medium green, light green, greenish yellow and yellow slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; slightly shiny underneath; nearly round with cordate base; lightly cupped, lightly corrugated and deeply leathery

Scape: 16 to 19in (40.6 to 48.3cm) high; green streaked with greenish-yellow

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 1.88in (4.8cm) long; pale lavender, ; tubular; Ann Arbor, MI; 7/17 - 7/30 - 8/12

Seed: sets viable seeds, green or streaked pods

Clump History: original seedling; 6 years old; Ann Arbor, MI

Notable Characteristics: unusual small highly streaked leathery blue-green pod parent
