Plant: 30in (76.2cm) diameter; 30in (76.2cm) high; upright to mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 6.5in (16.5cm) long; 3.5in (8.9cm) wide; 9 vein pairs; creamy white with 1in (2.5cm) wide, medium green, flat margins; very shiny on top; very shiny underneath; ovate with rounded base; folded

Scape: 22 to 23in (55.9 to 58.4cm) high; pink

Scape Bracts: medio-variegated inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1.5in (3.8cm) long; medium lavender, ; tubular; Mansfield, OH; 7/23 - 8/4 - 8/20

Seed: sets viable seeds, pink to red pods

Clump History: original seedling; 4 years old; Mansfield, OH

Notable Characteristics: banana colored center, leaves stick out of clump like a banana, pink scapes are topped with cherry red pods like a Banana Split
