Leaf: 12.75in (32.4cm) long; 10.75in (27.3cm) wide; 16 to 20 vein pairs; medium blue-green with 1.5 to 3in (3.8 to 7.6cm) wide, golden yellow, heavily rippled margins; glaucous bloom on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly folded, moderately wavy, moderately corrugated

Scape: 36 to 40in (91.4 to 101.6cm) high; green
