Plant: 36in (91.4cm) diameter; 10in (25.4cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 10in (25.4cm) long; 6.5in (16.5cm) wide; 12 vein pairs; medium blue-green heavy ripples to serrated margins; glaucous bloom on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with Cordate base; tip twisted, lightly folded at edge, intensely wavy, moderately flat

Scape: 40 to 0in (101.6 to 0.0cm) high; green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1.125in (2.9cm) long; medium lavender, ; tubular; Mansfield, OH; 8/25 - - 9/10

Seed: sets viable seed, green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 5 years old; Mansfield, OH

Notable Characteristics: borders all round up and have a very delicate ruffle terminating in a twisted tip
