Plant: 60in (152.4cm) diameter; 28in (71.1cm) high; upright; fast growth rate

Leaf: 11in (27.9cm) long; 9in (22.9cm) wide; 10 to 12 vein pairs; yellow to golden yellow streaked with slightly blue-green to medium green and light green, slightly rippled margins; dull on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; corrugated

Scape: 30 to 34in (76.2 to 86.4cm) high; light green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 3in (7.6cm) long; pure white, ; tubular; Rochester, MN; - -

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods

Clump History: the original sport; 7 years old; Rochester, MN

Notable Characteristics: tri-colored margin intensifies during season; margins are blue-green with areas of medium green and light green streaking, deeply impressed
