Plant: 36in (91.4cm) diameter; 16in (40.6cm) high; mound-like; slow growth rate

Leaf: 7in (17.8cm) long; 5in (12.7cm) wide; 12 to 13 vein pairs; intensely blue-green flat margins; glaucous bloom on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; moderately cupped, moderately wavy, deeply corrugated

Scape: 29 to 0in (73.7 to 0.0cm) high; blue-green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 2.375in (6.0cm) long; near white, medium purple stripe in mid-petal distinguishes this cultivar; tubular; Rochelle, IL; 6/22 - 7/3 - 7/15

Seed: sets viable seeds

Clump History: original seedling; 10 years old; Rochelle, IL

Notable Characteristics: purple 'flush' in the middle of each flower petal, rich blue foliage
