Leaf: 13in (33.0cm) long; 9.5in (24.1cm) wide; 14 to 15 vein pairs; dark green streaked with light green, medium green, blue green, yellow, greenish-yellow heavily rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly folded, deeply corrugated

Scape: 37 to 39in (94.0 to 99.1cm) high; glaucous green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2.1in (5.3cm) long; near white, pale lavender striping, translucent edges; tubular; Ann Arbor, MI; 7/19 - 8/1 - 8/15

Seed: glaucous green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 7 years old; Ann Arbor, MI

Notable Characteristics: large white backed multicolored streaked leaves on thick 22 inch petioles
