Leaf: 4in (10.2cm) long; 3in (7.6cm) wide; 7 to 8 vein pairs; slightly blue green with .25in (0.6cm) wide, creamy white, slightly rippled margins; glaucous bloom on top; dull underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly wavy

Scape: 14 to 15in (35.6 to 38.1cm) high; blue-green
