Plant: 24in (61.0cm) diameter; 17in (43.2cm) high; upright; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 6in (15.2cm) long; 5.75in (14.6cm) wide; 11 to 12 prominent under vein pairs; medium green streaked throughout with dark green, greenish yellow, yellow, pale yellow and creamy wh slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; glaucous bloom underneath; nearly round with cordate base; moderately cupped and moderately corrugated

Scape: 20 to 24in (50.8 to 61.0cm) high; glaucous medium green streaked with creamy white

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1.9in (4.8cm) long; pale lavender, ; tubular; Ann Arbor, MI; 7/6 - 7/21 - 8/1

Seed: sets viable seeds, medium green or streaked pods

Clump History: original seedling; 5 years old; Ann Arbor, MI

Notable Characteristics: small multi-colored seedling of 'Color Glory'
