Plant: 30in (76.2cm) diameter; 20in (50.8cm) high; upright; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 8in (20.3cm) long; 8in (20.3cm) wide; 15 to 17 vein pairs; bright green-gold with 3in (7.6cm) wide, blue, margins; glaucous bloom on top; glaucous bloom underneath; nearly round with cordate base; deeply cupped

Scape: 18 to 20in (45.7 to 50.8cm) high; light green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1.5in (3.8cm) long; pure white, ; tubular; Comstock Park, MI; 6/18 - 6/28 - 7/10

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods

Clump History: division; 7 years old; Comstock Park, MI

Notable Characteristics: Extremely thick leaves, much thicker than any other hosta. Strong, stiff petioles. Leaves are intense blue, cupped and puckered.
