Plant: 48in (121.9cm) diameter; 18in (45.7cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 11in (27.9cm) long; 9in (22.9cm) wide; 12 to 13 vein pairs; golden yellow slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; dull underneath; broadly ovate to nearly round with rounded to cordate base; lightly cupped, moderately twisted and folded, moderately wavy, lightly corrugated, deeply flat

Scape: 42 to 54in (106.7 to 137.2cm) high; light green to yellow

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 2in (5.1cm) long; near white to pale lavender, ; tubular; Indianapolis, IN; 6/20 - 7/5 - 7/25

Seed: sets viable seeds, light green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 12 years old; Indianapolis, IN

Notable Characteristics: very bright spring yellow fades to a light green, a most distinctive spring plant

Pod Parent: H. 'Bill Brincka'

Pollen Parent: unknown

Sport Parent: N/A

Seasonal Color Change: viridescent changes to a light green in late summer
