Plant: 24in (61.0cm) diameter; 24in (61.0cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 7in (17.8cm) long; 5in (12.7cm) wide; 9 vein pairs; golden yellow slightly rippled margins; very shiny on top; dull underneath; nearly round with rounded base; deeply corrugated and moderately folded

Scape: 30 to 36in (76.2 to 91.4cm) high

Scape Bracts: N/A

Flower: 2 to 2.5in (5.1cm) long; pale lavender, striped; bell; Iowa City, IA; 6/15 - 7/1 - 7/15

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods

Clump History: original seedling; 6 years old; Iowa City, IA

Notable Characteristics: golden yellow, with good substance, seersuckered and white backed
