Leaf: 8in (20.3cm) long; 6in (15.2cm) wide; 19 to 22 vein pairs; yellow with .2 to 1in (0.5 to 2.5cm) wide, dark green, slightly rippled margins; dull on top; glaucous bloom underneath; broadly ovate with cordate base; lightly cupped

Scape: 27.5 to 35.5in (69.9 to 90.2cm) high; medium green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 1.6in (4.1cm) long; pale lavender, striped; tubular; Wetheringsett, Stowmarket, Suffolk, England; 7/14 - 7/31 - 8/10

Seed: sets viable seeds, dark green pods

Clump History: 1st generation division; 5 years old; Wetheringsett, Stowmarket, Suffolk, England
