**Plant:** 35in (88.9cm) diameter; 18in (45.7cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

**Leaf:** 8in (20.3cm) long; 6in (15.2cm) wide; 9 vein pairs; medium green with irregular gold streaks with .125 to .75in (0.3 to 1.9cm) wide, yellow, flat margins; slightly shiny on top; dull underneath; Ovate with rounded base; lightly corrugated, moderately flat

**Scape:** 32 to 38in (81.3 to 96.5cm) high; green

**Scape Bracts:** inflorescence leaves

**Flower:** 2in (5.1cm) long; pale lavender, slightly darker striping; tubular; Edgecomb, ME; 7/20 - 8/1 - 8/25

**Seed:** sets viable seed, green pods

**Clump History:** original sport; 5 years old; Edgecomb, ME

**Notable Characteristics:** Gold streaks that lighten to cream are highly variable throughout the leaf and sometimes the margins as well.
