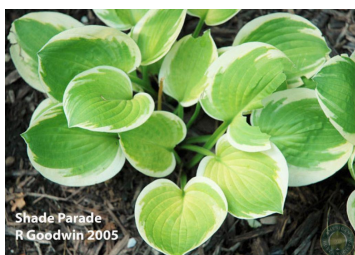

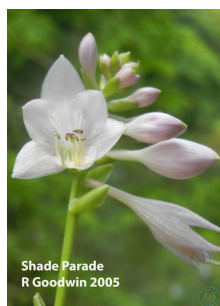

Plant: 12in (30.5cm) diameter; 8in (20.3cm) high; mound-like; moderate growth rate

Leaf: 3in (7.6cm) long; 3in (7.6cm) wide; 6 to 9 vein pairs; yellow with .25 to .5in (0.6 to 1.3cm) wide, creamy white (emerges pale green), slightly rippled margins; slightly shiny on top; slightly shiny underneath; nearly round with cordate base; moderately cupped, deeply corrugated

Scape: 15 to 0in (38.1 to 0.0cm) high; green

Scape Bracts:

Flower: 1in (2.5cm) long; near white to pale lavender, ; tubular; Indianapolis, IN; 6/5 - 6/15 - 6/20

Seed: sets viable seeds

Clump History: original sport; 10 years old; Indianapolis, IN

Notable Characteristics: small cupped corrugated with bicoloration
