Plant: 40in (101.6cm) diameter; 28in (71.1cm) high; mound-like; medium to fast growth rate

Leaf: 9.5in (24.1cm) long; 6.5in (16.5cm) wide; 14 vein pairs; light green margins; slightly shiny on top; slightly shiny underneath; nearly round with rounded base; deeply cupped, deeply corrugated

Scape: 18 to 28in (45.7 to 71.1cm) high; green

Scape Bracts: inflorescence leaves

Flower: 1.5in (3.8cm) long; pinkish white, ; bell; Lodi, OH; - -

Seed: sets viable seeds, green pods

Clump History: the original sport; 1 years old; Lodi, OH

Notable Characteristics: when sunlight or brightness strikes the leaf surface, a blue, blue-green, green iridescence floats over the leaf surface, much like a shark skin
