Leaf: 10.5in (26.7cm) long; 10in (25.4cm) wide; 14 to 16 vein pairs; golden yellow flat margins; dull on top; glaucous bloom underneath; nearly round with cordate base; moderately wavy, deeply cupped, intensely corrugated

Scape: 24 to 0in (61.0 to 0.0cm) high

Flower: near white, ; tubular; Raleigh, NC; 6/18 - 6/28 - 7/5

Seed: sets viable seeds

Clump History: a division of the original; 10 years old; Raleigh, NC

Notable Characteristics: heavily corrugated, deeply cupped, golden yellow foliage
